The Project

History

- 2011 – Project started
- Very poor urban community in Mombasa
- Compulsory state education = 100+ per class
- Little Faces = 35 children per class maximum

Currently there are 4 children on each desk instead of the 2 that they were designed for, making it very difficult for them to write properly.

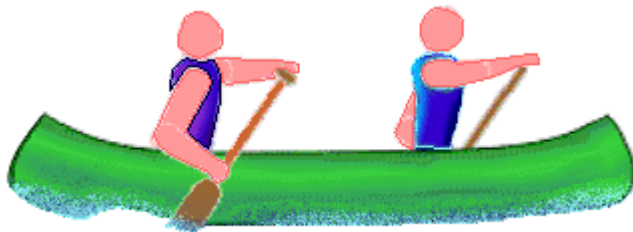
Many have the blackboard sideways on as the rooms are too small.
